## **GUIDE OF RESTAURANTS**

There are many restaurants in the area of *Paseo Marítimo* and the square *Ingeniero La Cierva* with good food. You can also find some of them of fast food but also some with typical andalusian food. Here goes some of them:

## **NEAR HOTELS (PASEO MARÍTIMO AND AVENIDA)**

Arte Serrano: Paseo Marítimo 2. Andalusian food of every type (meat and fish).

La Tienda de Vélez: Avenida Cayetano del Toro 17 (in front of McDonald's). Andalusian and International food of every type (meat and fish).

**BarraSiete:** Avenida de Amílcar Barca 17, corner of Callejón del Blanco. Typical food from Cadiz but with a modern viewpoint. You have to try *ensaladilla de gambas* and *dorada frita*.

Arsenio Manila: Paseo Marítimo 12. Mediterranean food.

## **CITY CENTER (ANCIENT CADIZ)**

*El Faro de Cádiz:* Calle San Félix 15. Very good. If you take a table, it is a little bit expensive, however you can eat at the bar at a normal price.

El Balandro: Alameda Apodaca 22. Mediterranean food.

**Casa Manteca:** Calle del Corralón de los Carros 66 (barrio de la Viña). Tipical place. For taking *tapas*.

*Freiduría Las Flores:* Plaza Topete 4 (Plaza de las flores). Typical fried fish from Cadiz. Recommended.

Sopranis: Calle Sopranis 5 (near Ayuntamiento). Modern food.

*La Curiosidad de Mauro Barreiro*: Calle Real 208. Near San Antonio Square. The chef got one Michelin star. Andalucian-sofisticated food but at a reasonable price.
